Simple Ways To Avoid Mould

- Open windows as much as possible to ventilate the property
- Check windows for blown double glazing and replace if possible as this may mean moisture is getting in
- Wipe off any condensation that's formed on the windows
- Install an extractor fan in the bathroom, use when having a shower or bath and clean regularly
- Avoid drying clothes inside as the moisture will evaporate and settle on walls and ceilings
- Use a dehumidifier to ensure humidity levels are kept below 50%
- Check the roof, plumbing and walls in case of a leak if damp occurs to avoid mould forming
- Get a damp survey if unexplained damp appear at the property
- Paint high moisture rooms with anti-mould paint and remove any mould before re-painting
- Keep doors shut to avoid moisture escaping from high moisture rooms such as kitchens and bathrooms to avoid damp air circulating the rest of the house
